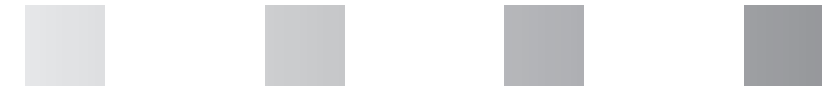

The numbers and letters below the Wine Board's symbol are a guide for our customers

White and Rosé wines are numbered 1 – 5
1 – the driest, to 5 the sweetest

Red wines are lettered A – E
A – the lightest, – to E – the most robust
